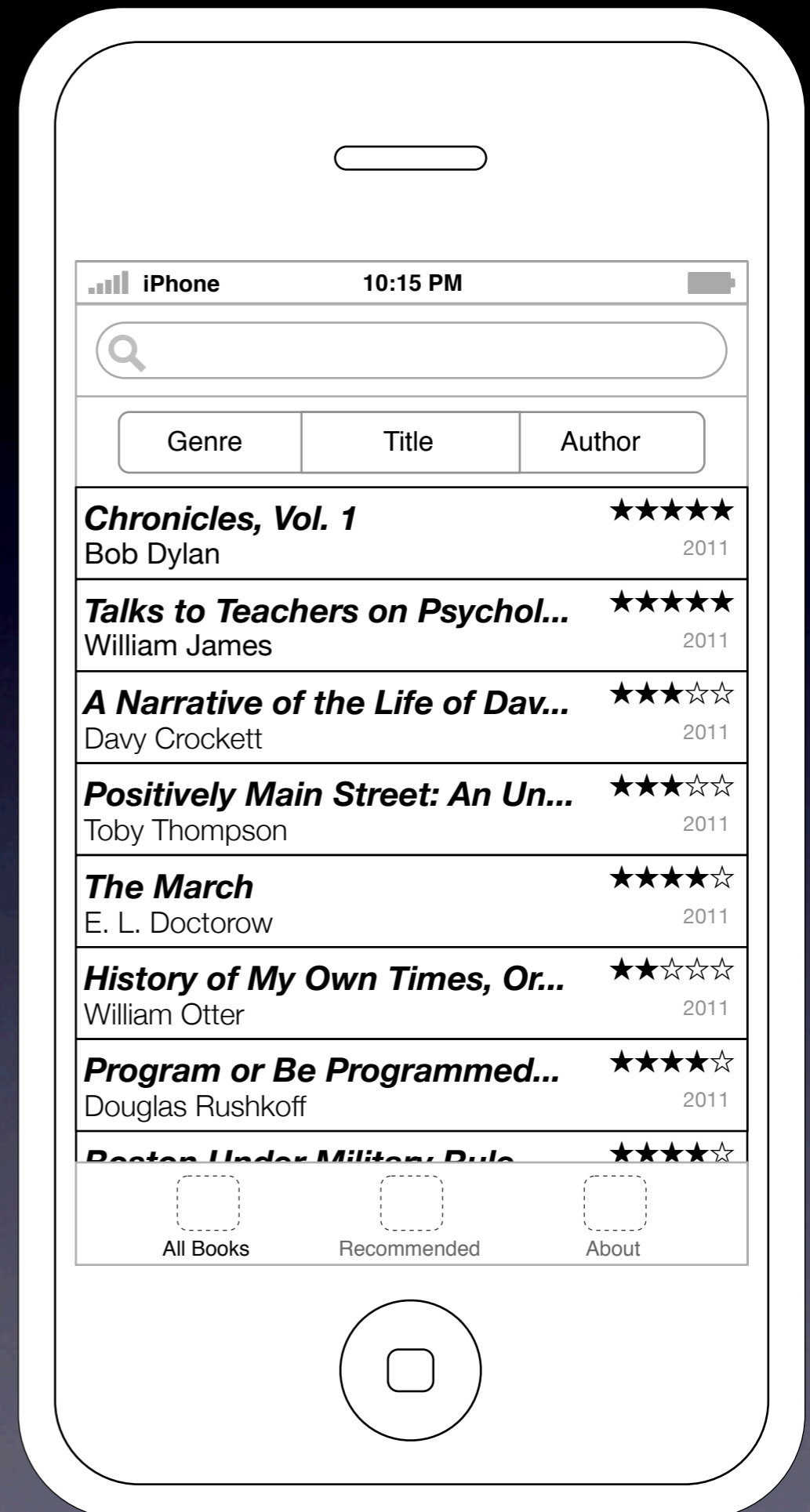

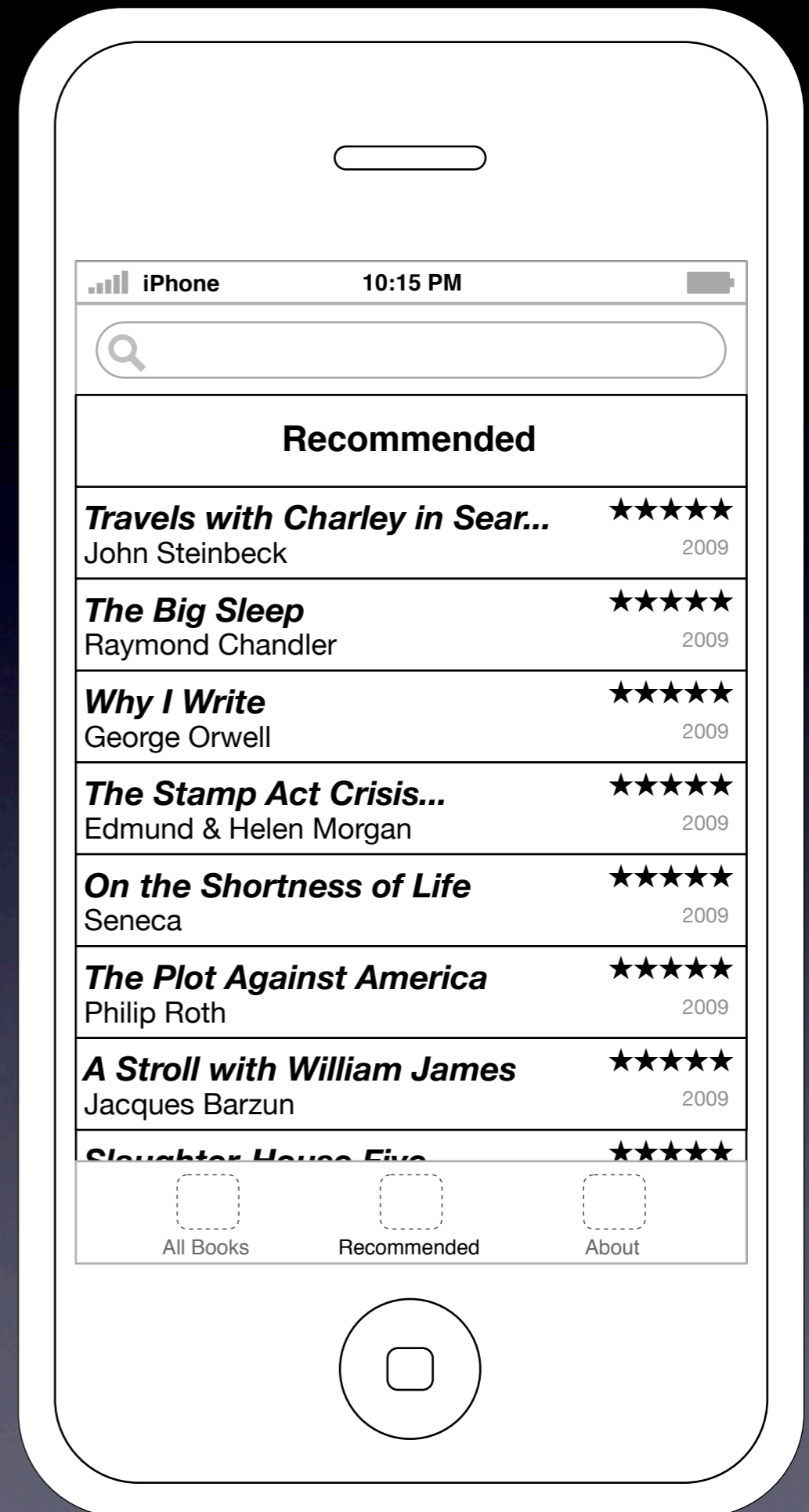


This is the default screen, a list view sorted by the order in which I read the books. It's mostly for novelty; without this view, newly added books would be more or less hidden.

Scrolling above the list reveals a search bar.



Here's what happens when you click "Recommended" - a subset of books that got 5 stars and have the right tag attached to them. For people who don't care about what I didn't like.



An individual book page, with content pulled from the database and from Amazon.com. I know the title of the specific page content should be in the title bar next to the back button, but because some book titles are so long, I left that space empty.

Links work as expected - clicking a tag will list the other books with that tag.
